REPEAT CHILD SEX OFFENDER

In 2009, the Supreme Court found Mark Trevor Marshall ‘**incapable of controlling, or unwilling to control, his sexual instincts**’ and jailed him indefinitely. Yet, less than two years later, the same court has cleared the way for his **release into the community**.

Mark Trevor Marshall has a history of sexually abusing vulnerable children dating back to 1987, when he was convicted of **thirteen counts of indecent assault against children and sentenced to a three-month suspended sentence**. The last time he was released back into the community he sexually abused children three times within a year.

We demand minimum mandatory sentencing for child sex offenders. The sexual abuse of a child is the most heinous offence and deserves a punishment that reflects the severity of the crime and the harm that it causes. Minimum mandatory sentencing will ensure paedophiles are taken out of circulation and put **in prison where they belong**.
